I believe that there is a wonderful energy afoot at St. Matt's that just needs a little structure and direction to find footing. A pastor certainly helps with this, but you yourselves are empowered to bring forward ideas or recycle ideas and recruit a few people and run with it. Take a look at upcoming events in the area and think how St. Matt's might have a presence there. Think about what sub-groups of your congregation maybe need special attention and nurturing right now. How might that happen? Think about road-trips and fellowship activities and ways to simply build up your intergenerational community by getting to know one another better. Keep the spirit of the fish fry going! Maybe a BBQ in the park? Who could you invite? Be on the look-out for what new things God might be doing among you and through you, beloved people of St. Matthew's.

You are an amazingly warm and lively congregation with many gifts to offer the community and region. Your community depends on you to be fully engaged in your shared ministry this Spring and Summer and beyond, to be brave in trying things, to trust that God is always out ahead leading the way. I am looking forward to what new things God will bring forth among you and through you in the months to come!


Our confirmands are encouraged to continue attending Wednesday Lent Services.
