#### Dear St. Matt's friends,

August is now upon us, and with it, thoughts turn toward Back-to-School Time. Even if you don't have kids in the house, I believe that there is something about this time of year (call it muscle memory) that gives rise to a yearning for a bit more structured schedule, and maybe turns us towards new learning opportunities. I hope so anyway. I hope that we never stop seeking opportunities to learn and grow, no matter our age!

I am looking to continue to grow myself. Always! Currently, I am three weeks into a nine-week class being offered through Faith Lead from Luther Seminary. I meet virtually with faith leaders from several denominations and from all over the country for a couple hours every Monday night to be taught skills of how to be an effective coach. A coach is not a counselor, mentor or consultant who offers advice. A coach is someone you talk to when you have a particular issue in your life that feels hard to untangle—be it professional, personal, relational or spiritual. When you are trying to sort out what you should do or how to address a particular concern, a coach <u>listens</u> deeply to your story and your values and utilizes powerful questioning to help you draw out the Spirit-led wisdom already within you. The coach helps you to form and articulate a plan for next steps and helps provide accountability and support for taking and assessing those steps. Part of this coaching process, if people are open to it, is praying with and for you.

I felt called to take this class because I believe this process deeply respects the Spirit's indwelling in each person. I see this learning already improving my ability to offer wise pastoral counseling and care-filled support for friends and family.

Consider this an invitation: If you ever need someone to talk to about hard-to-untangle issues going on in your mind, heart and life, please know that I am here for you. REALLY. Not to solve it for you, but to offer listening, support, and prayer and perhaps together, discovering a little more clarity about how God might be leading you forward.

In every season, may we never stop asking questions, seeking wisdom, learning and growing.





Here are a few thoughts about the job from Jill (who has been heard saying, "I don't know why we don't have more interest in this sweet little gig...")




