Dear St. Matthew's Family,

At the December council meeting, the call committee presented their report on the search for a pastor. During their many months of work they have received several names of candidates, but some were not a good fit for our church and others accepted different church calls, leaving us still without a candidate to call as our next pastor.

Earlier in the process, a member of the call committee reached out to Pastor Kristen Larsen-Schmidt, who had spent the Lenten season with us, to see if she was interested in making herself available to be interviewed for a pastoral call to St. Matthew's. She declined, being established in her hospice chaplaincy work. However, after leading worship with us on November 6 and learning we were still without a pastor, she contacted me and Pastor Brad in the synod office to suggest that she could possibly become available to serve as our interim pastor, on a part time basis and for a limited period of about 18 months.

To discern if this would be a good option for her and for the church, she updated her Rostered Ministry Profile. The call committee reviewed these papers and met with her for an interview in November. At the December council meeting, they unanimously recommended that St. Matthew's hire Pastor Kristen as interim pastor.

The church council in turn unanimously voted to meet with Pastor Kristen with the goal of signing an interim pastoral contract. We met with Pastor Kristen on December 21st and discussed the details of the contract with St. Matthew's. I am excited to report that Pastor Kristen has accepted an interim contract with St. Matthew's. She will start on January 16 and be with us until the end of May 2024.

This interim contract is different than most interim contracts. Usually, the Interim Pastor serves the church until a candidate is called by the congregation. In this case, the council will put a pause on the call process and not reform a call committee until the early spring of 2024. We will then begin the call process again.

This is also different from our experience with previous pastors in that while Pastor Kristen will be overseeing all worship planning and leading the education and programming of our church during this time, she is only contracted with us at 80% time, so she will be off approximately 20% of services and she also plans to continue her ministry with hospice a couple days each week.

The council is extremely excited Pastor Kristen will be sharing her gifts with St Matthew's. If you have any questions, please reach out to me or other members of the council.

Please join me in welcoming Pastor Kristen to our St. Matthew's family!


