

Church Insurance-working with insurance company and audit team. Policy renews in July. Right now building is valued at 1.8 million – do we feel replacement cost would be much higher and do we change the value? Council decided to keep the value at 1.8 million. John made a motion to keep the value at 1.8 million, keep the cyber liability and add an umbrella policy. We will also have a conversation with Ruby's Pantry on the insurance coverage. Beth seconded. MPU Church Sunday July 3rd - there will be services July 3rd.

Digital sign – currently there is no one in charge of changing the digital sign – it has basically been the same since Pastor Amy left. John will talk with Vione and we will see if we can get it changed in time to put VBS on there.

Acolyte Sign up – there is no one assigned during the summer. We will send an email to confirmation parents to ask them to sign up for a date for their student to acolyte.

Next meeting- no meeting in July.
