Dear St. Matt's friends,

This October we are celebrating the gift of Holy Scripture. On October 1, parents will fulfill part of their baptismal promises to their children by placing Bibles into the hands of their 3rd graders and storybook Bibles into the hands of kids new to Sunday School. The 6th graders also received age-appropriate Bibles from their parent's hands as they started confirmation last month. We are so thankful to our WELCA ladies for their generosity in purchasing these Bibles!

A confirmation student recently asked, "Why is so much of confirmation about learning the Bible?" Here is my response to her, in a bit longer form:

Through reading the Bible, we get to know our family history, starting with Adam and Eve, through the family tree of Abraham and Sarah, Jacob and Joseph and his 11 brothers, Moses, Esther, Ruth and Naomi, King David and the prophets. Our mothers and fathers of the faith were far from perfect, but through their stories we learn of God's faithfulness to them through the ages. We learn how the promises God made to them--of a homeland, an eternal kingdom, and a legacy of blessing all the families of the world-- are fulfilled in Jesus. And we learn that in Jesus, the promises were for us too, all along.

We get to know Jesus himself. We learn *about* him--his miracles, his surprising teachings, his advocacy for the poor and sick and marginalized. But we also get to know him personally, as God's divine son who became human at a particular time and place, but who then *transcended* that historical moment through his death and resurrection to be *a messiah for all of us*, right here and now--the pioneer and perfector of OUR faith (Hebrews 12:2), the one who knows us each intimately and calls us, (yes, us!) to follow him as "the way, the truth and the life." (John 14:6).

We learn Who We Are, ("You are precious in my sight, and honored and I love you" Isaiah 43) and how to live a life that is "really life;" a life defined by integrity, love, and service. Through the 10 commandments--and all of the people who broke those commandments, through Jesus' teachings about the ways of God's kingdom, and through all the New Testament writings, we learn that the command to "love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul and mind and strength and love your neighbor as yourself" is at the heart of all of it all.


Studying the Bible isn't just for kids! Just ask the guys who gather every Sunday to drink coffee, tell jokes, and....YES, read and discuss scripture. As they soak up the word and engage in honest conversation, they are gaining insight and hope for their everyday lives. I get to see it in real time and it's very cool. This month I am trying something new. Every Monday at 1pm, I am inviting whoever is interested to an informal time of Dwelling in the Word, where we will ponder one of the scriptures for Sunday and have coffee and conversation about how God is guiding us. Absolutely no experience necessary, and extra Bibles are on hand. All are Welcome.


Update On Pastor Kristen's Schedule:

I wanted to share with you all that after much discernment, prayer and discussion with my family this summer, I came to the conclusion that it would be best for me to discontinue my work as a chaplain for Hospice of the Red River Valley. My last day in that role was August 8. Although I highly value that work and I certainly miss my patients and colleagues, I felt that it was just becoming too stressful to try to faithfully serve both as Chaplain and as a pastor at St. Matthew's. I concluded that I had completed my time of service with hospice.

That being said, I just want to remind everyone (and myself!) that I am contracted with St. Matthew's as an Interim Pastor until the end of May at 80% time. This allows me the flexibility to be gone about one weekend a month for family commitments, and I am thankful for this.

I will continue my schedule of being at St. Matt's on Mondays and Wednesdays. I will plan to do parish work and planning from home on Tuesdays, and will often have additional work to do from home on Thursday when needed. As much as possible, I will be reserving the bulk of Thursday and and Friday for professional and personal projects outside of St. Matthew's work. You may still feel free to call or email me, but please understand that I may have other commitments that prevent an immediate response unless it is an emergency.

All Saints' Sunday is November 5




On this day we will light candles to give thanks for those who have inspired us in our faith and in remembrance of all those we love who have died in the faith and are now gathered home to God.
