#### Dear St. Matt's friends,

**September is the season of HOMECOMING**. I am not talking about the high school dance, though that will also happen this month. I am talking about a **Season of Returning**. Some are coming home from vacation. Students of all ages return to their second home--school. Hopefully it is a time when people feel the nudge to return to church as well? Because I miss seeing some of you!

I get it. Summer is filled with travel and commitments that take us away from town. For me too. And then, well, some people have been away from church for longer than just the summer, right? Maybe it's been a year or two. Maybe some checked out during covid times and haven't really been back since for various reasons. Maybe that's you or someone you know. The invitation is to COME HOME to God and to your own deepest self. Come find your place at the table and be fed with grace. That's why we're here. We are all making our way home to get our cups filled with love.

One of the things we are planning for September 10 is an **OPPORTUNITY FAIR**. This will be a time when the different teams of our church (Education, Youth, Worship, Fellowship, Outreach, and Properties –and perhaps WELCA, Men in Mission, Quilters, etc) will be stationed at tables ready to visit with people about their area of ministry. Our hope is that *everyone* in the church will become connected with at least one of these ministry teams. Being connected and involved is how we find meaning, purpose and a sense of belonging at church. It's how we, together, create a community where everyone feels at home.

**So please plan to join us on Rally Sunday, September 10**. Sunday School and Men in Mission Bible Fellowship is at 9, Worship is at 10. Fun and fellowship with the Opportunity Fair will be happening all morning, Invite your friends and neighbors and those you haven't seen in a while. To one and all—Welcome HOME.

# St. Matthew's Faith Formation





By Mail-You can mail your offering to 701 Broadway St. Thompson, ND 58278 if you are going to be out of town.


Automatic Bill Pay-Through your bank, you can set the church up to receive payment automatically. This helps keep the budget running even if you are away from church for an entire season.
